I create work that can be read just as easily, slowly, and quickly by people from within the art-world and outside as well. My main subject matter is the body. In the tradition of Chicago artists I distort and destroy the body while maintaining a fine balance between seduction and repulsion. In addition to traditional painting and drawing materials, I use craft and construction materials to bring my own body and history into the work.
